## PROGRAM OBJECTIVE

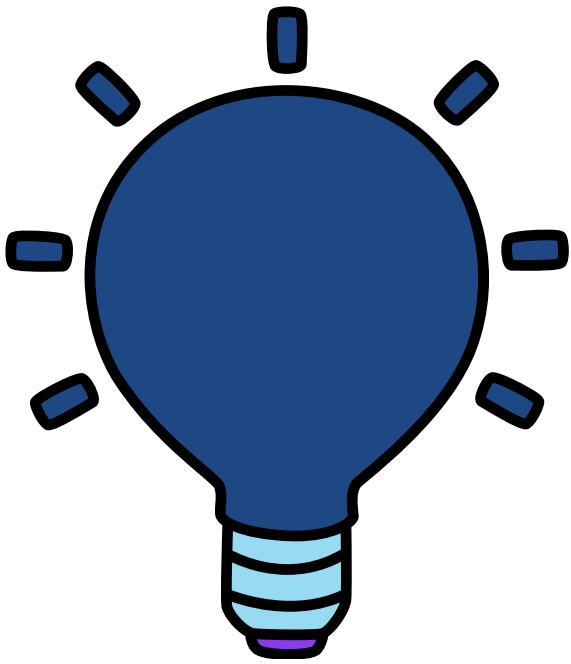
To equip mid-career and senior professionals in the textile and apparel industry with the knowledge and tools necessary to integrate ESG principles into their organizational strategies.

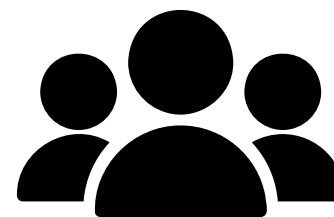


## WHO SHOULD ATTEND?
